

League Structure

WRALL is organized into ten leagues. We believe that children enjoy the game most when they are playing with other children with similar skills. Accordingly, the leagues are not strictly divided by age group and children may be moved to a higher or lower age league based on this belief.

T-Ball

T-Ball is a league for 4 & 5 year olds. T-ball will play 3 innings and every child will bat each inning. T-Ball is played with a softer core ball than a regular baseball for safety. Tball is designed to be the first level of play for the children and teach them the basics of baseball and softball. Boys and Girls play on the same teams in T-Ball.

Rookie Ball

Rookie Ball is a league for 5 & 6 year olds. Rookie Ball will play 5 innings and 3 out Baseball. Rookie Ball will use many of the same rules as Coach Pitch Baseball except they will hit off a T and have 2 coaches in the outfield on defense. All Players will remain in the field on defense. Rookie Ball is played with a softer core ball than a regular baseball for safety. Rookie Ball is designed to transitions the child from T-Ball to Coach Pitch. Boys and Girls play on the same teams in Rookie Ball.

Coach Pitch Baseball

The Coach Pitch League is primarily for 7 & 8 year olds. The ball is pitched by a coach. This league will play three out baseball and play six innings. Six year olds can petition to play up in the coach pitch division but must have played one year of T-Ball and must be drafted by the 7th round.

Coach Pitch Softball

The Coach Pitch League is primarily for 7 & 8 year olds. The ball is pitched by a coach. This league will play three out softball using a continuous batting order and play six inning games. Six year olds can petition to play up in the coach pitch division and must be selected by the 7th round.

Minor League Baseball

Minor is our first kid-pitch league. It is comprised primarily of 9 year olds and some 10 year olds. The League uses a continuous batting order where each kid gets to bat and each child has to play at least 6 outs in the field. This league uses a pitch count mandated by Little League Baseball. 8 year olds can petition to play in the Minor League division but must have played one year of Coach Pitch Baseball and must be selected by the 7th round. This league is split into two divisions and includes interdivisional play.

Minor League Softball

Minor is our first player-pitch league. It is primarily for of 9 and 10 year olds. The League uses a continuous batting order where each player gets to bat and is required to play at least 6 outs in the field. This league is split into two divisions and includes interdivisional play.

AAA Baseball

Triple A is for 10 & 11 year olds. The AAA Division is new to WRALL this season. The League uses a continuous batting order where each kids gets to bat and each child has to play at least 6 outs in the field. This league uses a pitch count mandated by Little league Baseball. 9 Years olds can petition to play in the AAA division and must be drafted by the 7th round. This League is split into two divisions, East and West and includes interdivisional play.

Major Softball

The Major League is primarily for 11-12 year old players. All 11 and 12 year olds must attend assessments for Major League. Ten year olds are allowed to petition to play in Major League but must be drafted by the 7th round. Once the evaluations are over, teams will be formed by means of a draft. This league is split into two divisions and includes interdivisional play.

Major Baseball

The Major League is our highest and most competitive level of play. All 11 and 12 year olds are eligible to try out for the Major League, but team numbers and roster space do limit the total number of participants in the Major League. Ten year olds are also allowed to petition to play in Major League. Once the evaluations are over, teams will be formed by means of a draft. All 11 and 12 year olds MUST try out to be eligible to play in either Triple A or Major League.

Eleven year olds not drafted into Major will be drafted into the Triple A League. Like AAA, the Major League is divided into the East and West Divisions. The season includes interdivisional play.

Jr/Sr Softball

Jr/Sr Softball is a combined league for our players ages 13-16. Unlike our other divisions, no player younger than 13 years old will be permitted to participate in the league. Game length is 7 innings. Teams will be formed by means of a draft after player assessments are complete. This league is split into two divisions and includes interdivisional play.
